International Youth Tournament

Regulations

Boys U7

Playing time: 1x 10 minutes (no rest). The mentioned playing time applies to both group and final matches. If final matches result in a draw after the applicable playing time, a penalty shootout will take place.

Number of players: 4 per team (no goalkeeper), unlimited substitutions.

Officials: Game Leader (Fair Play). If this is not respected, the team will be excluded from further participation.

Field size: minimum 30x20 meters

Target area: None

Ball size: 3 -> 290 grams

Penalty kick distance: None, penalties are not awarded.

Yellow card: not applicable, a player will be substituted if necessary.

Red card: only in case of extreme misconduct a player will be sent off the field. In that case, a replacement may be brought in.

Bank misconduct: if this is the case with the youngest youth, the team will be allowed to continue playing, but without coaches

Offside: No

Free kick: This is only given in exceptional cases. This may be taken by dribbling the ball, passing the ball or shooting from the spot where the free ball has been given.

Corner Kick: Corner kicks are taken from the corners of the playing field by dribbling, passing or shooting the ball. In all cases, a goal can be scored directly by the player who takes the corner kick.

Goal kick: This is taken from the ground within the goalkeeper's area by dribbling, passing or shooting the ball. The back ball can be taken by either the goalkeeper or a field player. The opponent is at least 5 meters away.

Throw-in or kick-in: On an outbound ball, the game is restarted by dribbling in. Passing and/or shooting is not allowed. After the ball has been dribbled in, the player who dribbles in can score.

Kick-off: After a goal has been scored, a player from the team that has conceded a goal dribbles the ball next to their own goal. Opposing players start in their own half.

Back pass: A back pass (played through a foot) may not be picked up by the goalkeeper. If this is done, the student referee will explain that this is not allowed. If the violation is

repeated, an indirect free kick will follow nine meters from the end line. A back pass that does not go through the foot (shin, knee, upper body and head) may be picked up.

Spectators/parents: Members of the public, other than the trainer, coach (max 2 people) or substitutes, are located at a WIDE distance from the field, so not ON the side or back line. If this does happen, the game leader stops the game.
